



Neighbors Served First: A Volunteer Agreement

When you volunteer with a Member of the Food Bank of Northeast Georgia, you join in a vision of EVERY NEIGHBOR. WITH ENOUGH FOOD. EVERYDAY. To ensure that our neighbors facing food insecurity can access food in a welcoming and safe environment, please follow these guidelines:

- Follow the instructions of the Site or Pantry Coordinator regarding safe food handling and your role throughout the distribution
- Communicate with neighbors in a manner that reflects the Food Bank's values of Belonging, Compassion, Dignity, and Stewardship
- Maintain a safe environment for neighbors, volunteers, and others by staying aware of your surroundings

Important: If you need food for yourself or someone you know, you may receive food through the normal intake and distribution process after most of the neighbors have been served. If you are volunteering, *you may not set aside food for yourself or anyone else at any time*
